



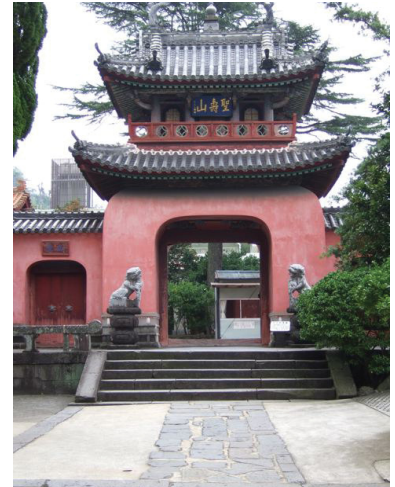

**Raising Eyebrows: The Journal Meiyu, 1914-1916 and the Regulation of

Michel Hockx is Professor of Chinese at SOAS, University of London. He obtained his PhD from Leiden University in 1994, for a thesis on modern Chinese poetry. Since then, he has done research on aspects of the production and distribution of literary texts in modern China, including a book-length study of Republican-period magazine literature (Questions of Style, Leiden: Brill, 2003) and a forthcoming monograph on PRC online literature (Internet Literature in China, New York: Columbia UP, 2012).
