## **History and the Development of Chinese Foreign Policy**

Professor Kawashima Shin

Professor Kawashima Shin teaches the history of international relations in East Asia at the University of Tokyo Komaba Campus. He was educated at the Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (B.A.1992) and the University of Tokyo (Oriental history, M.A.1992, Ph.D, 2000). Previously he taught at Hokkaido University (Department of Politics, Faculty of Law, 1998-2006) and moved to the University of Tokyo in 2006. He has studied at Academia Sinica in Taipei, Taiwan (1995-96) and held visiting teaching positions at the Beijing Center for Japanese Studies (2000-2001), National Chengchi University in Taipei, Taiwan (2005) and Beijing University (2005). His research mostly focuses on analyses of Chinese diplomatic history based on Chinese diplomatic archives and sources. Among the numerous books, articles and edited volumes he has produced over the years he is the author of *Chūgoku kindai gaikō no keisei* (*The Formation of China's Modern Foreign Policy*) which was awarded the Suntory Academic Prize, and *Kindai kokka e no mosaku 1894-1925* (*Moves Toward a Modern State, 1894-1925*).
