## Fund details

### **Martin Hinds Travel Fund**

Grants will be made to assist registered Graduate Students and other members of the University in statu pupillari with the cost of travel to, and residence in, the Islamic Middle East and North Africa, in order to permit them to pursue the study of the languages, culture or history of those areas. Individual awards will not normally exceed £250 and priority will be given to applicants undertaking language courses.

### **AJ Arberry Travel Scholarship**

This award is offered every 3 years and is intended to foster an interest in Arabic and Persian studies in English-speaking parts of the Commonwealth. Candidates must be students whose mother tongue is English and who are citizens of the Commonwealth of Nations.

The Scholarship shall be awarded to a student who has shown distinction in Arabic or in Persian or in Arabic and Persian in any part of the Asian and Middle Eastern Studies tripos, preference being given to a student who has shown distinction in both subjects.

NB Awards to students are conditional. A student in Part 1A or Part 1B may apply for the Scholarship for his/her subsequent year of study (not the Year Abroad) and any award would be CONDITIONAL upon him/her gaining a distinction in Tripos.
