### Section B.

- 6. Discuss three developments (social, religious, or technological) that occurred during the Song Dynasty and explain their significance in Chinese history.

#### Section C.

- 7. What can we learn about family life, and particularly the lives of women, from the novel *Jin Ping Mei*?
- 8. What can we learn about Chinese perceptions of death and the afterlife from the episode of Taizong's journey through the netherworld in the *Xiyouji?*
- 9. What role did Manchu ethnic identity play in the establishment of the Qing and its rule over China?
